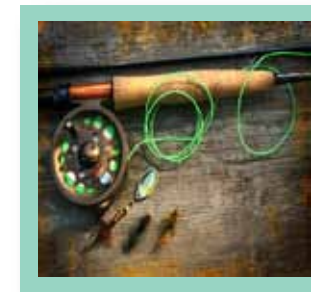

Outdoor Sports

Our **1/2 day wade trips** take place in the surrounding areas of Leatherwood Mountains. We fish both wild or hatchery supported trout waters. The fish in these streams include brown, rainbow and brook trout.

The morning 1/2 day wade trip leaves the shop at 8:00am and returns around 12:30.

The afternoon session starts at 1:00 and returns around 5pm. All equipment, rods and flies will be provided. Lunch and NC fishing license not included.

1 person - \$120; 2 people - \$200

Our **boat trips** take place on W. Kerr Scott Reservoir, just a short drive from Leatherwood Mountains. The reservoir supports numerous small mouth, large mouth & striped bass populations. W. Kerr Scott is as you would expect a mountain lake to be - pristine, low-traffic, with a healthy supply of fish to catch.

The full day boat trips start at 8:00am. You will need to drive a short 20-minutes down Hwy. 268. The full day of fishing ends around 4:30pm.

Snacks and drinks are provided. The marina on the lake serves up a great lunch. All tackle and equipment are provided for this adventure. Spinner & Fly rods will be used. NC fishing license not included.

1 person - \$350; 2 people max - \$400

Our **full day wade trips** take place in the surrounding areas of Leatherwood, but full day trips allow for longer time to explore the area and fish places that can't be reached on the 1/2 day trip. The streams and creeks you will encounter are both wild and hatchery supported. The fish include brown, rainbow and brook.

This trip leaves the shop around 8:00am and returns around 4:30pm.

Snacks and drinks are provided on this trip, as well as all your equipment, rods, & flies that you will need for a full day of fishing. NC fishing license not included.

Sessions take place at Raymond's Pond in Leatherwood and at the beautiful Leatherwood Campground. Reservations should be made at least a week prior. Morning and afternoon sessions available. All tackle and equipment is provided. NC fishing licences are NOT required at the pond, but are required (and not included) in the campground area.

Come take a ride with us and experience W. Kerr Scott Reservoir - named one of the cleanest and most pristine lakes in North Carolina. There is no better way to spend the day than aboard our 22' Harris Kyot Sunliner Pontoon Boat. Our boat can accommodate up to 15 people, including crew, or smaller, more intimate gatherings. The canopy ensures comfort for our sun-sensitive guests.

We will treat you 2 or 4 hours on the lake - traveling to hidden coves and open water, and cruising along the beautifully protected and preserved shore line. Be on the lookout for numerous bird species while aboard...we've seen Bald Eagles, Common Loons, Great Blue Herons, Ospreys, Wood Ducks, Cormorants, and many other impressive bird species. We will provide the official birding checklist so you can check off what you'll encounter on your journey. Your captain, Jon Swaim, is a wildlife and fisheries biologist, so if you have any questions, he will be sure to have an answer for you.

Remember to pack your camera, sunscreen, beach towels, and video cameras. We will supply you with ziplock bags to protect your electronics in while not in use. Bring your ipod/itrip and listen to your favorite music through the onboard radio, or let us provide you with the genre of your choice. The marina on the lake offers great hamburgers, hot dogs, french fries, ice-cream and other summertime fare at very reasonable prices. Large numbers of HUGE carp swarm in one spot at the marina waiting to be fed, and you can buy fishfood (popcorn) to feed them - always fun for the kids! Many swimming opportunities will arise as well, and we will bring some fun floats for your use.

Our **morning trips** will take off from the Ranger's Station at 8am.

We will return about 12 from the 4-hour trip and about 10 from the 2-hour trip. We could depart again at 10, depending on what is booked for the day. The cooler will be packed with soft drinks and water for everyone on board. There will also be munchies such as muffins, crackers, and trail mix.

COST: 2-hour, 2 - 4 people = \$75; 4-hour, 2 - 4 people = \$150

Our **afternoon trips** will push off from the Ranger's Station at 12:30pm.

We will return about 4:30 from the 4-hour trip and about 2:30 from the 2-hour trip. We could depart again at 2:30, depending on what is booked for the day. The cooler will be packed with soft drinks and water for everyone on board. There will also be munchies such as chips, crackers, and trail mix.

COST: 2-hour, 2 - 4 people = \$75; 4-hour, 2 - 4 people = \$150

Our **sunset cruises** will depart the Ranger's Station at 5:30pm.

We will return just after dark, around 8pm. This is a wonderful excursion for couples or family. We will provide you with soft drinks, water, soda crackers, red grapes, trail mix and a selection of fine cheeses. This is a wonderful way to end the day!

COST is \$100 for 2 - 4 people

Reservations are required at least 2-days in advance
